Join Live Zoom Q & A to Learn About Critical 2020 Ballot Issues

The League of Women Voter’s North County San Diego will provide a live Zoom Question and Answer session on 2020 General Election ballot measures on Friday, October 9th at 5:15 p.m.

Did you know that there are 10 State propositions and a Measure S specific to Solana Beach on this year’s ballot?

As a nonpartisan political organization whose mission is to encourage informed and active participation in government at all levels, providing critical voter services with community partners is especially important in an election year when significant policy matters will be decided. As in years past, the Society is sponsoring this Question and Answer session for our members. Information about the session and how to register and participate also will be publicized in our local media so that non-members can participate.



How to Participate

1. View the League’s prerecorded *Pros and Cons* presentation, a nonpartisan, unbiased summary of each state and local ballot initiative, the financial impact of the proposition, key supporters and opposition, and financial contributions made in support of or opposition to the measure.
